



VENDOR SELECTION PROCESS

Thank you for your interest in vendor opportunities with the PNC 2nd Street Market. The Market, owned and managed by Five River MetroParks, is located at 600 East Second Street in downtown Dayton. Housed in a renovated railroad freight building, the 2nd Street Market is home to over 40 local farm, floral, food and gift vendors. The Market has been at its current location since November 2001, but it has roots in the Dayton community as the Wegerzyn Farmer's Market that was established in 1975.

The Market's mission is, "To support small local entrepreneurs, with emphasis on food, agricultural, gardening and home décor, in an atmosphere that provides a comfortable and inviting gathering place for the diverse population of the greater Dayton area."

The vendor selection process starts by completing a short form that asks for contact information and briefly describes your business. If space is available at the Market and if your product line fits in one of the categories below, you may be asked to complete a more detailed application. Those applicants selected to be in the final phase of the process will be interviewed by a committee of MetroParks staff.
