ABOUT:

Found on hillsides and ridges in well-drained to dry soils. Although its nuts are usually bitter, squirrels, chipmunks and raccoons eat them.



5-7 leaflets that are yellow in fall

SEED



Round nut encased in a ridged husk that partially splits open in fall

BARK



Rounded ridges
