

# RED OAK

Quercus rubra (KWURK-us ROO-bruh)

## **ABOUT:**

The fastest growing of the oaks, this tree is found on northern- and eastern-facing wooded slopes. This large shade tree provides good cover and nesting sites, including cavities, for a variety of birds and mammals. A wide variety of large and small mammals and birds eat its acorns.
