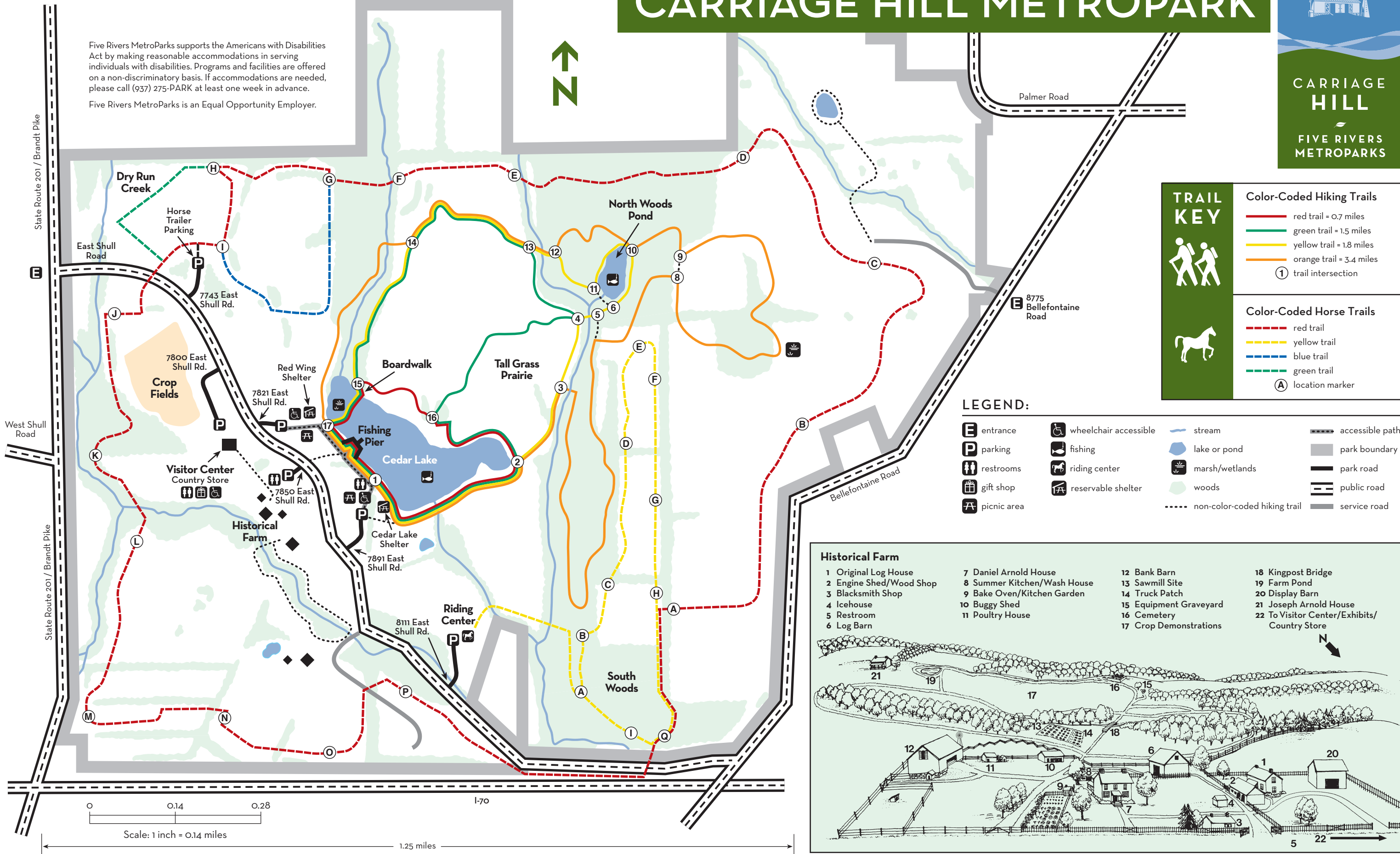

Color-Coded Horse Trails

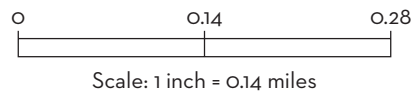
