<u>Law Enforcement Activity:</u> The BOPC was presented with the Law Enforcement Activity Report for June 2018.

Adventure Central Job Experience and Training (JET) Program: The BOPC was presented with an overview of the Five Rivers MetroParks' JET Program. JET students Terence Brookshire and Nate Winston provided testimonials on how the program has positively impacted their lives.

Budget Adjustment Resolution(s): Chief of Administration Bill Tschirhart requested approval and adoption of Resolution 18-013 to adjust appropriations in the general fund, capital fund, and grant funds. On a motion by Commissioner Davis, the BOPC adopted Resolution No. 18-013.

<u>Five Rivers MetroParks Levy:</u> Executive Director Rebecca Benná requested approval and adoption of Resolution No. 18-014 to submit a request to the

Montgomery County Auditor to certify the current total tax valuation of Montgomery County and the total revenue that would be generated by a 10-year, 1.8 mill replacement levy plus an increase of 0.2 mills, with the intent of placing the levy on the ballot for the November 6, 2018 general election. On a motion by Commissioner Davis, the BOPC adopted Resolution No. 18-014.

<u>Other Business:</u> The BOPC was presented with the WRGT-TV45 Get Out & explore Your MetroParks Series schedule. WRGT is featuring 16 different Five Rivers MetroPark locations which will be aired on the morning show through October 10, 2018.
