<u>Minutes:</u> The BOPC was presented with the minutes of the regular meeting for February 8, 2019. On a motion by Commissioner Saunders, the minutes were approved.

<u>Financial Reports:</u> The BOPC was presented with the February 2019 financial information and approved list of bills for February 1–28, 2019. On a motion by Commissioner Saunders, the BOPC accepted the financial reports as presented.

<u>Law Enforcement Activity:</u> The BOPC was presented with the Law Enforcement Activity Report for February 2019.

<u>Englewood-Aullwood Garden MetroPark Master Plan Overview:</u> The BOPC was presented with an overview of the Englewood-Aullwood Garden MetroPark Master Plan and the process used to create it.

Land Acquisition Amendment Request: Executive Director Rebecca Benná requested approval to increase the Clean Ohio Grant local match payment by \$46,240 in order to meet the purchase price agreed to with the owner of the Markey Farm property located at 13251 Anthony Road. On a motion by Commissioner Saunders, the BOPC approved the request as presented.

<u>Budget Adjustment Resolution:</u> Executive Director Rebecca Benná requested approval and adoption of Resolution 19-006, authorizing budget appropriation adjustment requests. On a motion by Commissioner Saunders, the BOPC adopted Resolution No. 19-006.

## ODNR Grant Resolution(s):

- Executive Director Rebecca Benná requested approval and adoption of Resolution No. 19-007, to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR), Division of Parks & Watercraft for funding of the 2019 Boating Safety Education Grant. On a motion by Commissioner Saunders, the BOPC adopted Resolution No. 19-007.
- Executive Director Rebecca Benná requested approval and adoption of Resolution No. 19-008 to establish the budget for the 2019 Boating Safety Education Grant administered by the ODNR Division of Parks & Watercraft. On a motion by Commissioner Saunders, the BOPC adopted Resolution No. 19-008.

Other Business: Executive Director Rebecca Benná announced that the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission (MVRPC) has approved federal funding through the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) for 2023-2024 which includes two Five Rivers MetroParks projects: Deeds Point Pedestrian Bridge replacement at \$2.1 million and the Wolf Creek Trail Extension at \$3.179 million.
